





DID YOU KNOW? By Hank Stahl '66

They took away our building, but not our soul and memories. While thinking back on my years at North, I started to wonder about a myriad of normal.....and not so normal facts about our Alma Mater.

DID YOU KNOW?

The school was purchased for \$150k from the Pennsylvania RR in 1926. When the school closed, it sold for millions. There were a whopping 98 students who graduated in that first class in 1929; 1,103 in the largest class in

North at one time was the largest Catholic high school and had the largest alumni in the world. At it's peak in 1953, enrollment was 4,726. The original building was built for 1,500 (thank goodness for the later addition of the Annex). When the Archdiocese decided we were no longer viable (their words; NOT OURS) enrollment was 551. North was proud to have students from 98 parishes to grace our hallowed halls. When NC closed, there were 65.

From it's inception, the Falcons won more Philadelphia Catholic League titles in soccer (22); bowling (18); wrestling (13); and baseball (11) than any other school. The Falcons also garnered eight basketball; football and swimming titles during that time. In addition, there were four track; three cross-country and two crew titles.

The list of academic achievements are too numerous to mention and the list of notable grads is a veritable plethora

of "who's who?" Tuition ranged from zero dollars to thousands during our reign. And despite the physical doors being closed, the Alumni Association continues to provide tuition assistance through its scholarship fund. So, when you think of keeping us 'alive' contribute to THE FALCONWAY. It's one way to make sure "THE FALCON WILL NEVER DIE!"




